*While this district has 53.3% Latino citizen voting age population (CVAP), African Americans comprise 39.9% of the district's CVAP, thereby placing the groups in unnecessary competition for electoral opportunities.

Notes: Latino effective districts are generally determined by the share of Latino citizen voting age population, which must closely approach or be at least 50% of the district.
