## 2010 Survey of Latino Registered Voters in Four Key States – Select Cross-Tabulations

*June 14 - 22, 2010*

The NALEO Educational Fund commissioned a poll of the Latino registered voters in four key states with open or competitive Gubernatorial or Senatorial contests in November 2010, led by Dr. Ricardo Ramirez, Assistant Professor of Political Science at the University of Southern California. The survey interviewed 1,600 Latino registered voters, by telephone June 14-21, 2010, 400 each in California, Colorado, Florida, and Texas. Together, these four states are home to 3 in 5 potential Latino voters. The margin of sampling error for the entire sample is plus or minus 2.5 percentage points; for each of the four states it is 4.9 points. For subgroups in the total sample and within states, the error margin may vary.
